### Project Goal

- The LITP assists low-income taxpayers resolve their IRS controversies by linking eligible taxpayers with volunteer attorneys who provide representation for the taxpayers before the IRS.

### The Process

- The LITP completes an intake and eligibility screening for all potential clients.
- LITP staff contacts a volunteer to discuss the taxpayer's case. The volunteer has complete control over whether to accept the case.
- If the referral is accepted, referral paperwork is sent to both the client and the volunteer. The client has the burden of making the initial contact with the volunteer.

### The Benefits

- The LITP provides an opportunity for volunteers to perform pro bono service to needy, low-income taxpayers and their families in their communities.
- The LITP provides ongoing case support, including help obtaining needed information about the case, assisting with client communications, and/or connecting a volunteer with a mentor.
- LITP volunteers have access to Pro Bono's annual training seminars, materials, and lending library.
