The Prosecutor prosecutes misdemeanor domestic violence cases investigated and charged by the Manchester Police Department (MPD), handling cases from arraignment through final disposition.

Responsibilities include:

Responsibilities include working under with a team of seven prosecutors, two of whom staff the Domestic Violence Unit. The City uses a fully-digital case management system, working in conjunction with MPD record management and body-worn camera technologies to meet the highest standards of excellence.

Essential Physical Abilities

- Prosecutes criminal cases;
- Engages in trauma-informed interactions with victims of domestic violence, in collaboration with victim advocates;
- Collaborates with other City attorneys to evaluate and improve performance for future work;
- Attends meetings, conferences, workshops and training sessions to become and remain current on the principles, practices and new developments with respect to victimcentered, trauma-informed prosecution practices;
- Thorough knowledge of criminal law;
- Ability to communicate effectively with others, both orally and in writing;
- Ability to perform a wide variety of duties and responsibilities with accuracy and speed under the pressure of time-sensitive deadlines;
- Ability and willingness to quickly learn and put to use new skills and knowledge brought about by rapidly changing information and/or technology;
- Integrity, ingenuity and inventiveness in the performance of assigned tasks.

Required Special Qualifications

- Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Juris Doctorate degree;
- Some prosecutorial experience;
- Admission to the New Hampshire Bar; and
- New Hampshire driver's license or access to transportation.
