**Summary:**

The Domestic Violence Program Manager is a full-time position within the New Hampshire Court System, contingent on legislative funding. This role requires strong independent judgment to support the Judicial Branch's response to domestic violence and stalking. Responsibilities include overseeing protection order processes in Circuit and Superior Courts, managing the Protection Orders Registry and staff, ensuring compliance with laws and regulations, supporting audits and corrective actions, coordinating grants, and working with court personnel, judges, and external partners on related policies, protocols, and forms.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

Graduation from an accredited four-year institution of higher learning with a bachelor's degree in human services, social work, criminal justice or a related discipline; Juris Doctorate preferred. At least five years' experience in domestic violence policy, advocacy, family or criminal law work; experience in court or related supervisory work is desired. Substitution of appropriate experience and education will be considered by the hiring authority.

**Special Requirements:**

Successful completion of a background check, including criminal records and motor vehicle. Must be able to successfully pass the FBI certification for NCIC usage and oversight.
