

PROSECUTOR

The Franklin Police Department has an opening for a police prosecutor position. The Police Prosecutor is responsible for the preparation and prosecution of misdemeanor and violation-level offenses in the Franklin District Division Court. This position works closely with police officers, victims, defense counsel, and the court system to ensure cases are handled efficiently, ethically, and in accordance with New Hampshire law.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to: Review arrest reports, citations, and investigative materials, prepare and present cases in court, provide legal guidance to police officers, meet with victims and witnesses, ensure compliance with discovery obligations, maintain accurate case files, coordinate with the Merrimack County Attorney's Office, stay current on changes in the law, and attend training as required.

Applicants must have a Juris Doctorate from an accredited university, be a member in good standing with the New Hampshire Bar, and have prior prosecutorial experience

Salary ranges from \$98,717 to \$132,808. The City of Franklin offers a comprehensive benefits package and enrollment into the NH retirement system.
